



Fee Booth Removal

ROD managed and maintained a two-man crew for the removal of the fee booths. Removal included torching off 8" bollards, with a 30-minute fire watch after removing each bollard. The crew utilized a mini excavator and bobcat to fill a 16-foot dump trailer and a 7-cubic yard dump truck. The construction debris was hauled to Foothill Sanitation Landfill, which is 15 - 20 miles away from the project site. Work was performed as the Park continued to host its residents and visitors.



All fee booth sites were maintained by removing all debris and trip hazards. ROD ensured that noise and dust were at a minimum, and traffic control was performed. Booths that had live electrical utilities were disconnected and abandoned. The construction crew also cut rebar and ground it. Concrete patch work was done where necessary.

The job was completed in two days. The project was within budget and there were zero safety incidents.
